18. **Abusive**: Uses intimidation or violence to maintain control over others, often employing psychological manipulation as well.
19. **Treacherous**: Untrustworthy, willing to betray even those closest to them if it serves their agenda.
20. **Immoral**: Lacks a moral compass, often justifying heinous acts to justify their ends.
